Abstract:

The Hilda E. Moore Papers contains professional and personal materials from Moore's life and time as librarian and director at the University of Maryland at Baltimore's Health Sciences Library. The materials are dated from 1930 to 1993.

Biographical History:

Hilda Elizabeth Moore was born in Stapleton, VA on March 20, 1914. She graduated from Randolph-Macon Women's College (now Randolph College) and then from Emory University of Georgia with her Master of Library Science.

She worked at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and Florida State University before becoming the Pharmacy Librarian at the University of Maryland in 1944. During her 32-year tenure at the University of Maryland, Baltimore she also served as Medical Librarian, Associate Librarian as head of Public Services (1952-1965) and director of the Health Sciences Library (1965-1976). Moore was a certified Medical Librarian. Hilda E. Moore died on July 9, 1993.
