Post-Labor Day Testing Reminder

UMB issued guidance last week requiring any student, faculty, or staff member coming to campus between Sept. 7 and Sept. 26 to submit a new COVID-19 test result during that period. For some, this is a second/additional test to the one required before the semester began. This also includes students, faculty, or staff members who will be visiting the Universities at Shady Grove in Rockville, Md.

You may come onto campus between those dates even if you have not yet obtained a new COVID-19 test. You are simply required to obtain a test at some point during that time frame.

Students and employees who did not get a COVID-19 test before Sept. 7, but plan to be on campus between that day and Sept. 26, are required to obtain a COVID-19 test within 14 days prior to your first day on campus.
