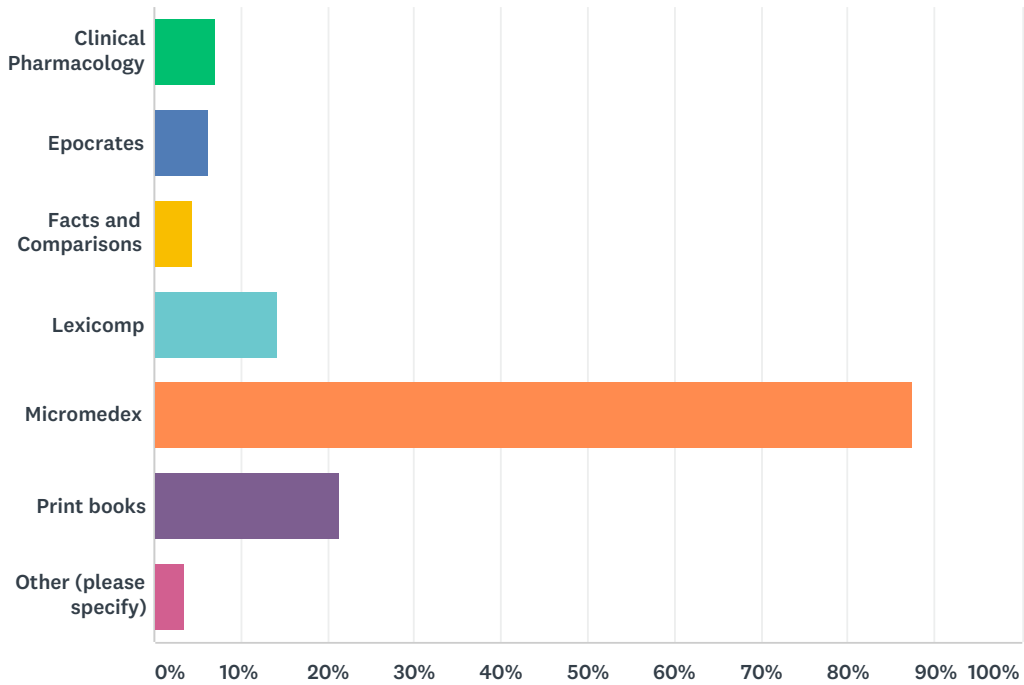


Q1 What drug information resources were you familiar with prior to today's class?

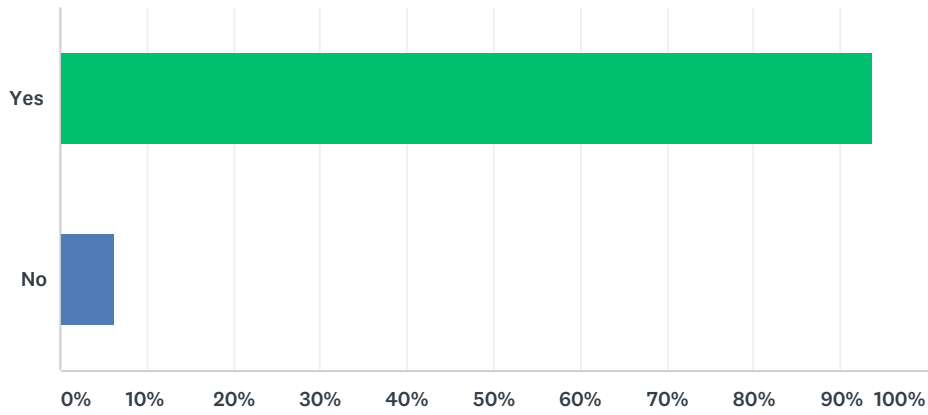

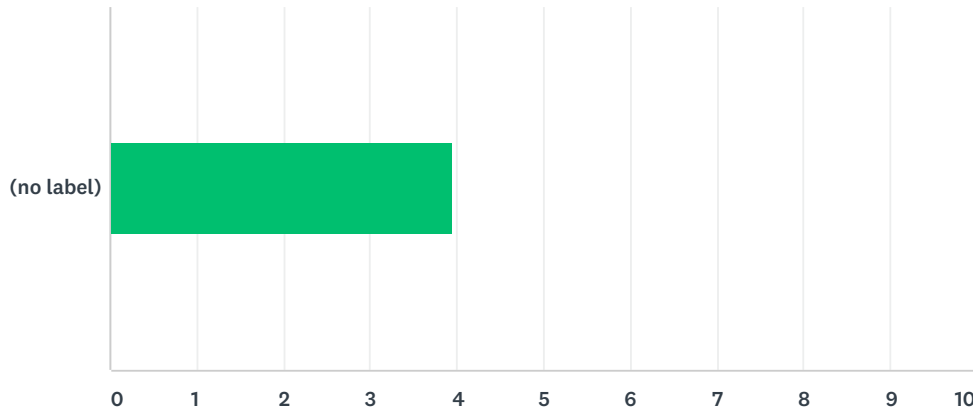
