Dear UMB Community:

Next week, the University of Maryland, Baltimore's fall term will end on Wednesday, Dec. 23. We hope that you have a restful, safe, and healthy break.

We've changed the post-break testing requirement date from Jan. 1 to Jan. 10, 2021. Therefore, as of Jan. 10, each student, faculty, and staff member approved to be on campus will be required to have a COVID-19 test that was taken within 14 days prior to their first day on campus. Limited exceptions to this policy have already been communicated to those affected.

The negative COVID-19 test result must be uploaded into SAFE on Campus (or Castle Branch) before arriving on campus. We strongly encourage you to have your test taken as close as possible to your return-to-campus date.

Please heed the guidance shared to not travel or gather in groups outside of your household over the holiday break. While the news of a COVID-19 vaccine is exciting, it will be awhile before we are all vaccinated and it is safe to engage in group activities once again.
