Professor Ferencz has been a mentor to legions of UMAB's medical and graduate students and will continue her research through an NIH MERIT award.

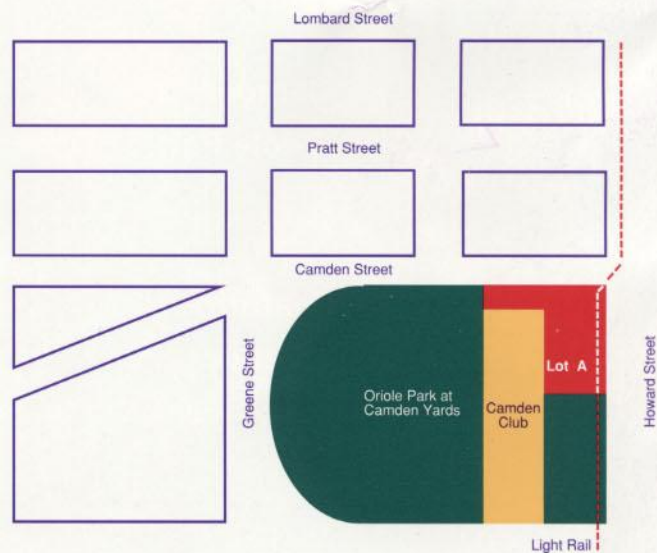
