



Streamlined Path to AGPCNP Certification

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Need for Streamlined Path

- In 2016 the Adult Nurse Practitioner and the Geriatric Nurse Practitioner exams were retired.
- Those NPs holding these certifications are at risk of losing their ability to remain certified.
- Most of these NPs were educated at the MS level.
- The AACN is recommending all APRNs be educated at the doctoral level.
- Provides plan of study to obtain AGPCNP certification
 - Without unnecessary duplication of course work
 - Obtain a doctoral degree and the ability to serve in a faculty role
 - Supports online education where appropriate for working adults
- Will increase Faculty and APRN workforce

Streamlined Path

- Provides plan of study to update certification to AGPCNP and earn a DNP without unnecessary duplication of course work
 - Plans available for ANP, GNP and ACNP
 - Can complete in as few as 48 credits
 - Supports online education where appropriate for working adults
 - For those with prior doctoral degree: Post Doctoral Plans available in 13- 29 credits
- Will increase Faculty and APRN workforce

- NURS 723 Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics across the Life Span
- NDNP 819 Advanced Health Assessment Across the Life Span
 - If completed Adult Health Assessment could substitute NDNP 725 Advanced Pediatric Pathophysiology, Developmental Assessment and Health Promotion to meet the Lifespan requirement

**All clinical placements will be geared toward filling gap in educational practice gaps from prior APRN education to meet the requirements of AGPCNP certification.

***AGACNP/ANP prepared NPs seeking new certification will need to complete additional clinical hours to meet the 500 hour requirement for certification exam

****Only required for ACNP or GNP prepared students

*****Not required for GNP students

Evaluation and Sustainability

- Expect to see an increase in applications to AGPCNP program with specific emphasis on those MS prepared NPs seeking to update their certification.
- As part of a school wide evaluation plan the project will be evaluated via:
 - Course Evaluations
 - Curriculum committee review
 - Employer and alumni survey
 - Student progress and graduation rates
- Successes and lessons learned will be presented at National Faculty Conferences to allow other Universities to recreate this method of increasing doctoral prepared APRNs
- The increased number of students and its seamless integration with existing programs will provide the support to continue the project at the completion of the funding cycle.
