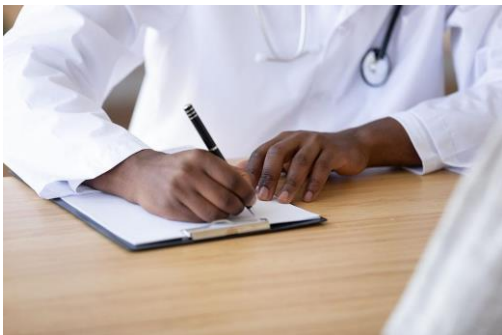
A Safe Place to Isolate
