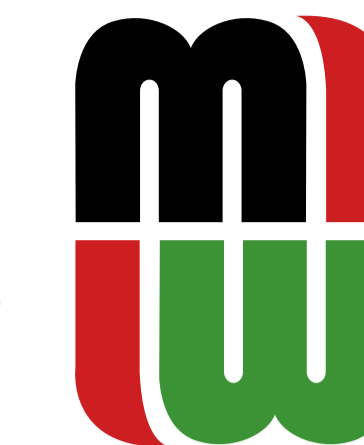


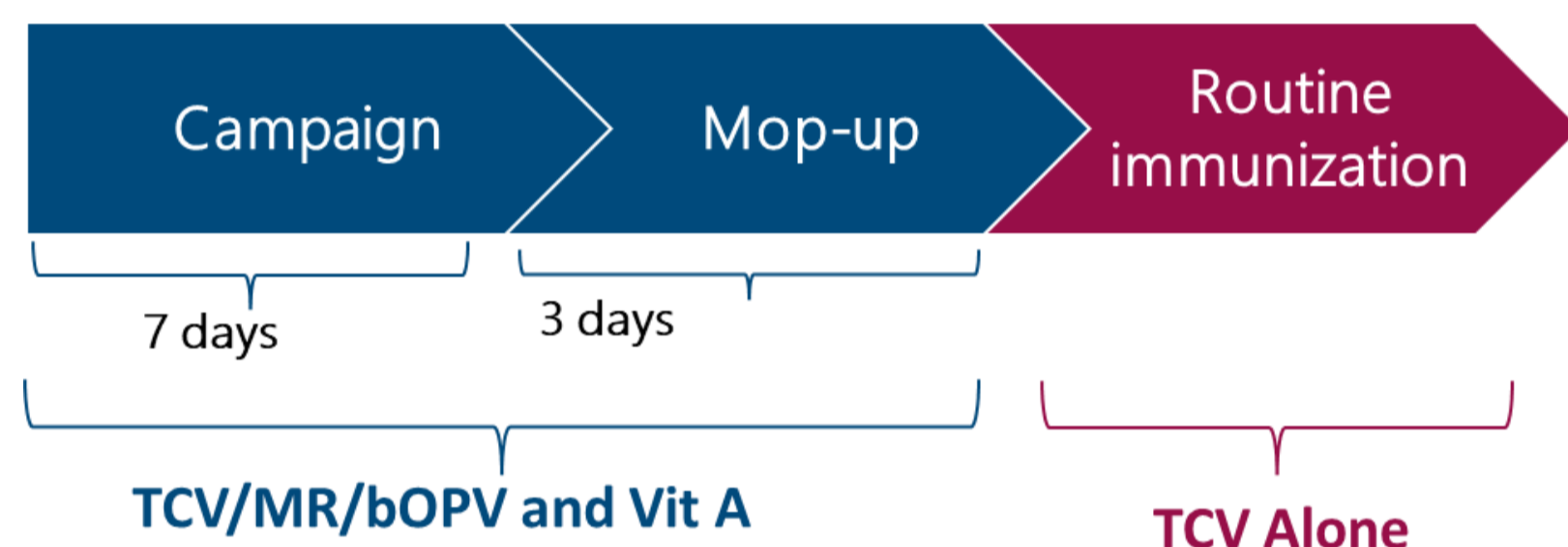
Integrated Typhoid Conjugate Vaccine Campaign and Introduction in Malawi



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Introduction

- Malawi **integrated** campaign and introduction, April 2023
 - Typhoid conjugate vaccine (TCV), measles-rubella (MR), bivalent oral polio vaccine (bOPV), & vitamin A (Vit A).
- Target age: Campaign, 9 months - 14 years, routine immunization, 9 months - 5 years.
- Vaccination documented in campaign card (Fig 1) and health passport for routine immunization (Fig 2).

- Decreased access due to flooding from Cyclone Freddy.
- Increased waterborne diseases.



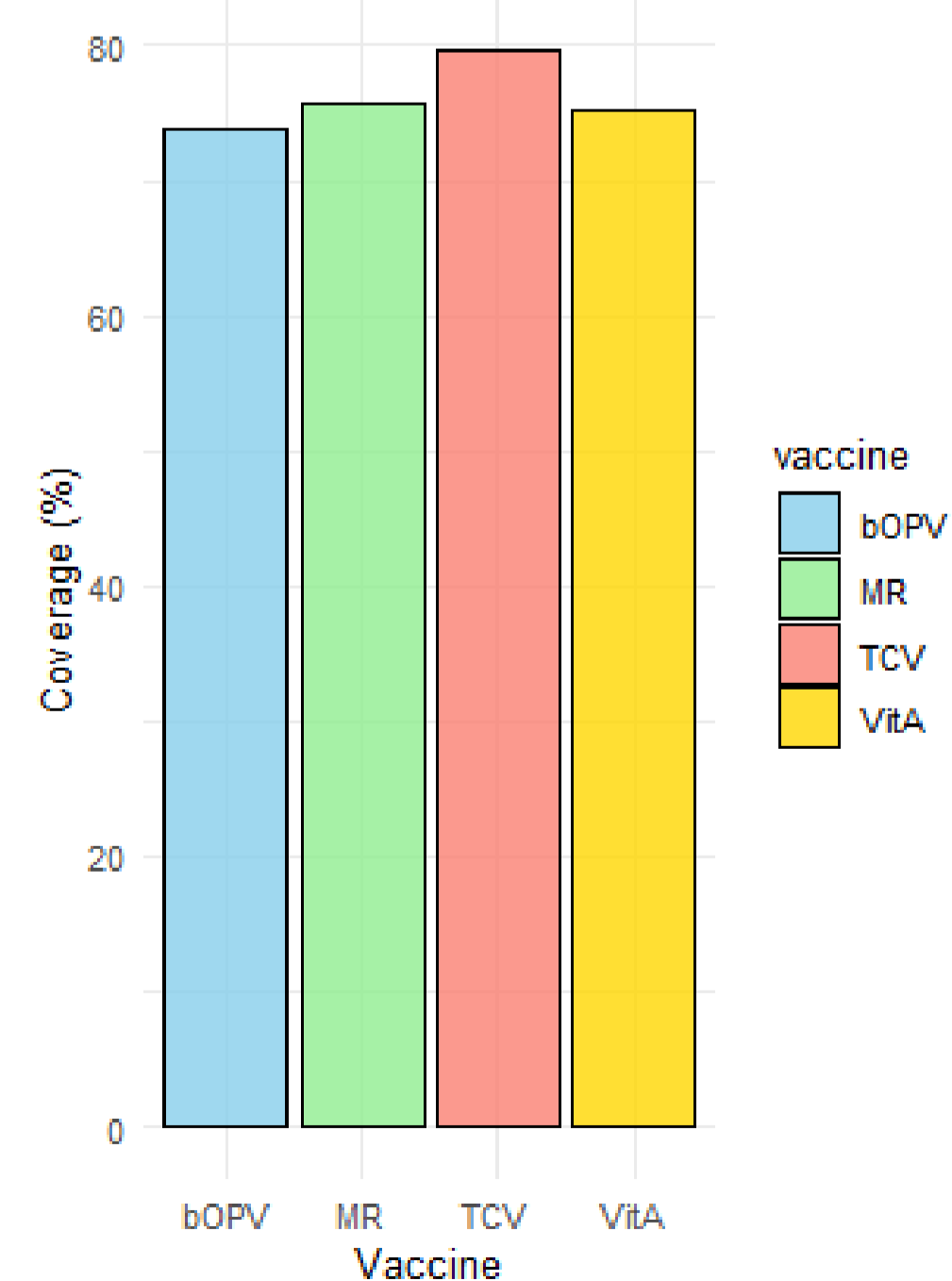
- Competing campaigns, malaria, cholera, & Covid-19.

Campaign strategies

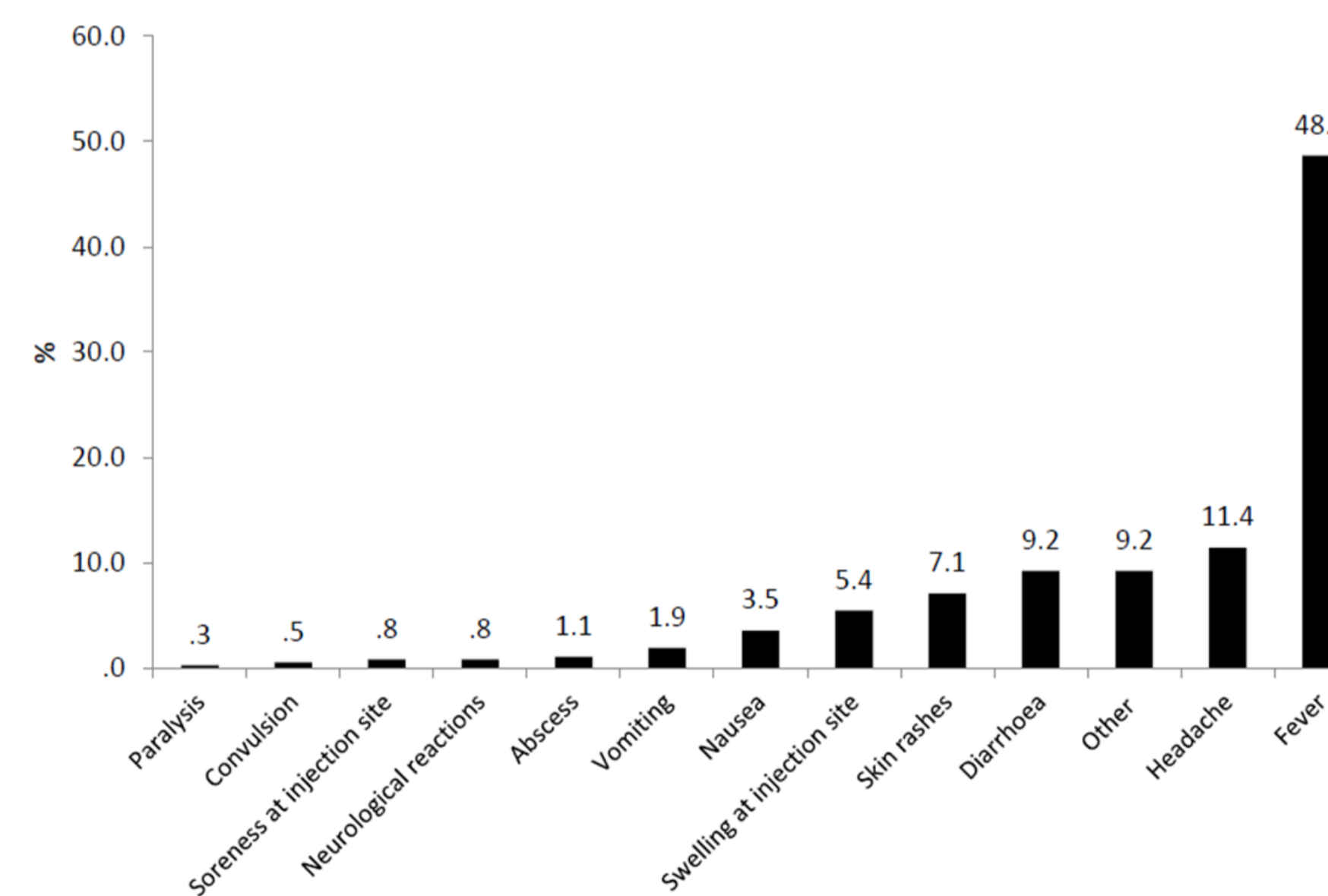
- Static sites** (house with cross icon): Public and private facilities. Vaccination and storage points for supplies.
- Outreach sites** (shop icon): Established community sites.
- Mobile sites** (school icon): Schools, churches, and orphan centers (Fig 3).
