The Maryland State Chapter of The American Physiotherapy Association has received replies from questionnaires sent out in regard to Red Cross enrollment. According to your letter of March 15 there were no physical therapy technicians from the State of Maryland enrolled.

Our latest report from thirty-eight Maryland physiotherapists shows the following:

Married-----	4
To be married-----	2
Total	<u>30</u>

This questionnaire was sent out before the notice was received that married women are now eligible. Several of our married members have written for enrollment blanks. The eight members who intend to enroll were encouraged to do so promptly.

We realize that the National Association is anxious for co-operation from all chapters and we are doing all we can to encourage enrollment.
