Dennis Miller

Dennis Miller is recognized as one of America's most literate and articulate mainstream comedians. While his humor is often cerebral and abstract, he can be extremely pointed and blunt. Miller appeared on *Saturday Night Live* from 1985 to 1991, and hosted *Dennis Miller Live* for nine years on HBO beginning in 1994. The show aired 245 episodes and netted five Emmy Awards. Miller was color commentator for ABC's *Monday Night Football* in 2000 and most recently hosted *Dennis Miller* which aired on CNBC from 2004 to 2005.
