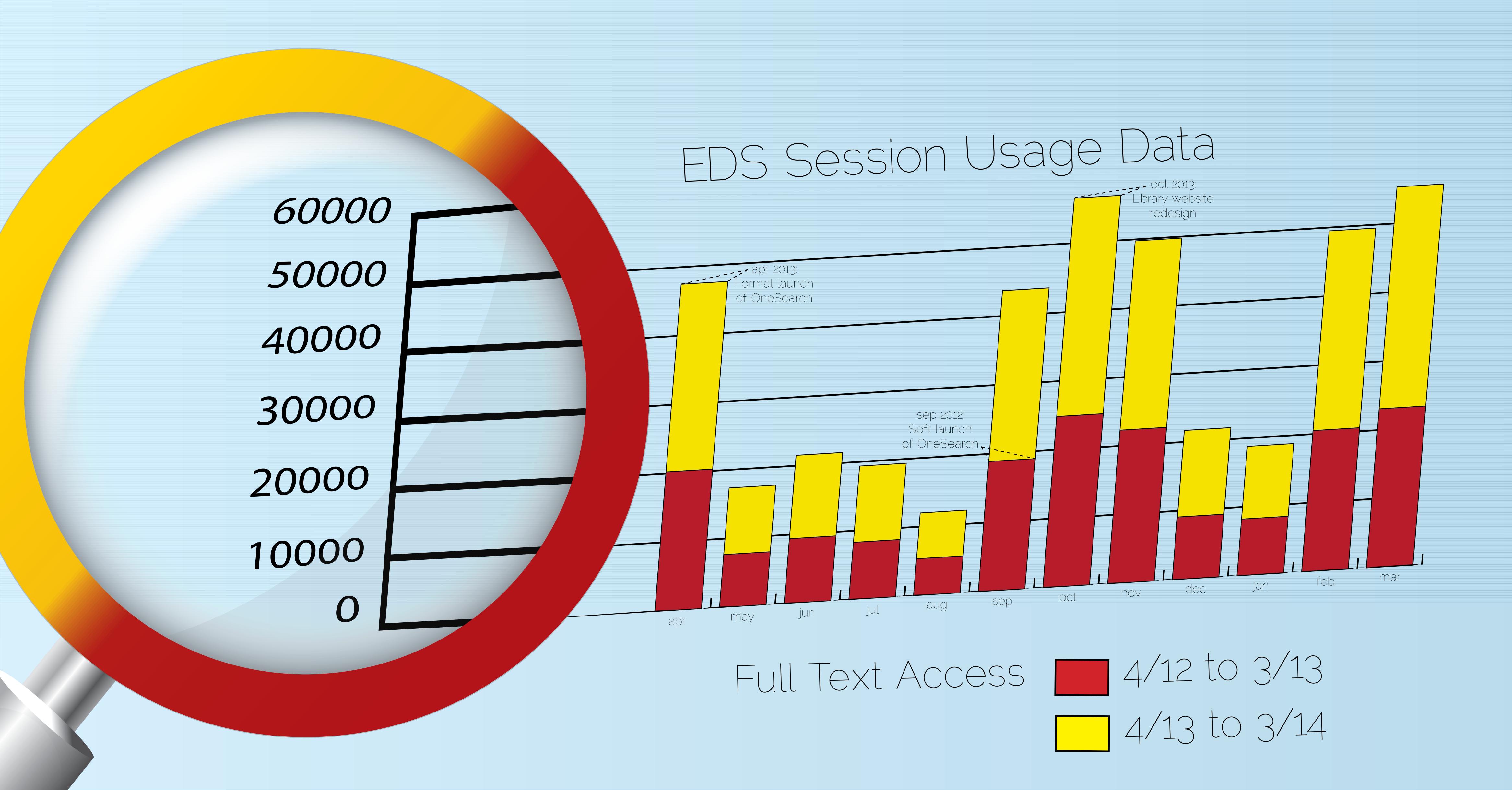
Collaboration Delivers a New Search Experience to HS/HSL Users
