ON-TIME GRADUATION RATE

Data are collected in May of each year and represent the percentage of a class which successfully completes the Doctor of Pharmacy within the expected four year timeframe. Late graduation may be due to academic delays, medical/maternity leave or enrollment in a dual degree program.
