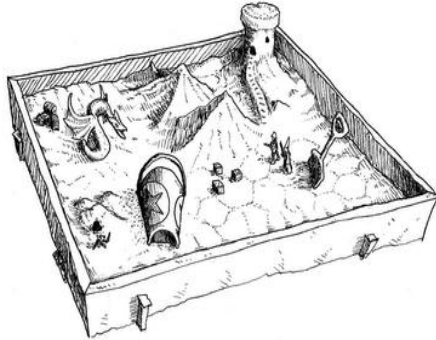

Course Description: The overall objective is to give librarians an opportunity to “touch & feel” the functionality of an electronic health record system EHR in a demo environment. Through guided instruction, lecture and **videos, students will practice accessing the functions of the EHR. Practice exercises include charting, custom texts, adding/registering new patients, alerts/warnings, medication reconciliation, patient scheduling, meaningful use and billing. Students will act as clinicians enabling assignment of ICD-9 codes, treatment plans and patient education information.
