



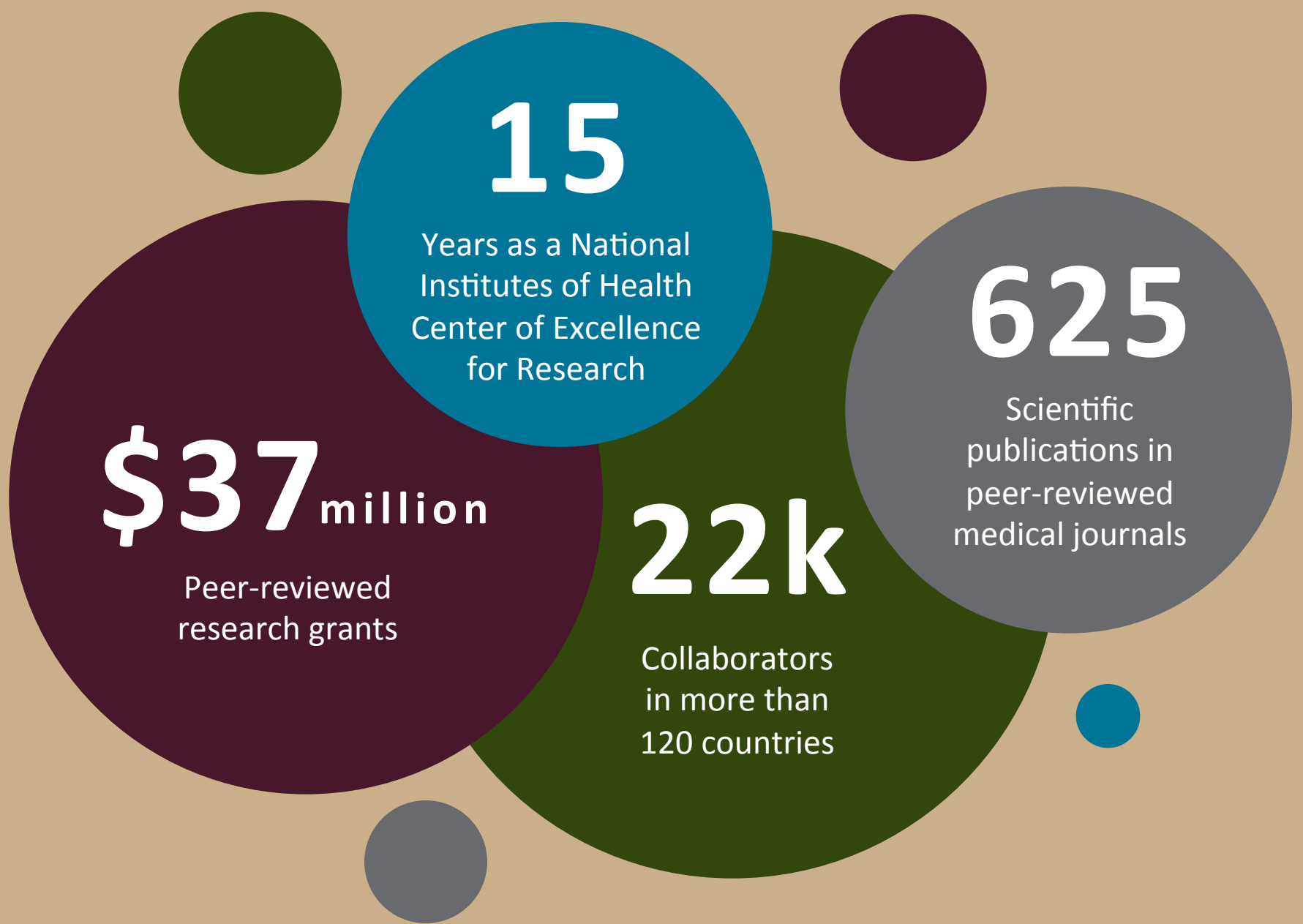

Founded in 1991 by Brian Berman, MD, the **Center for Integrative Medicine at the University of Maryland School of Medicine** was the first U.S. academic medical center-based program in integrative medicine.



Robust **research program** includes studies on acupuncture, nutrition, exercise and mind/body therapies focused on arthritis, pain, inflammation, cancer, depression, trauma, addiction and more.



Coordinating center for the **Complementary Medicine Field of the Cochrane Collaboration** since 1996 – gathering over 58,000 clinical trials and coordinating the worldwide effort to systematically review and provide summaries of the evidence for integrative medicine.

Clinical practice made up of a diverse team of doctors and licensed integrative practitioners, including acupuncturists, massage therapists, nutritionists and more.
