

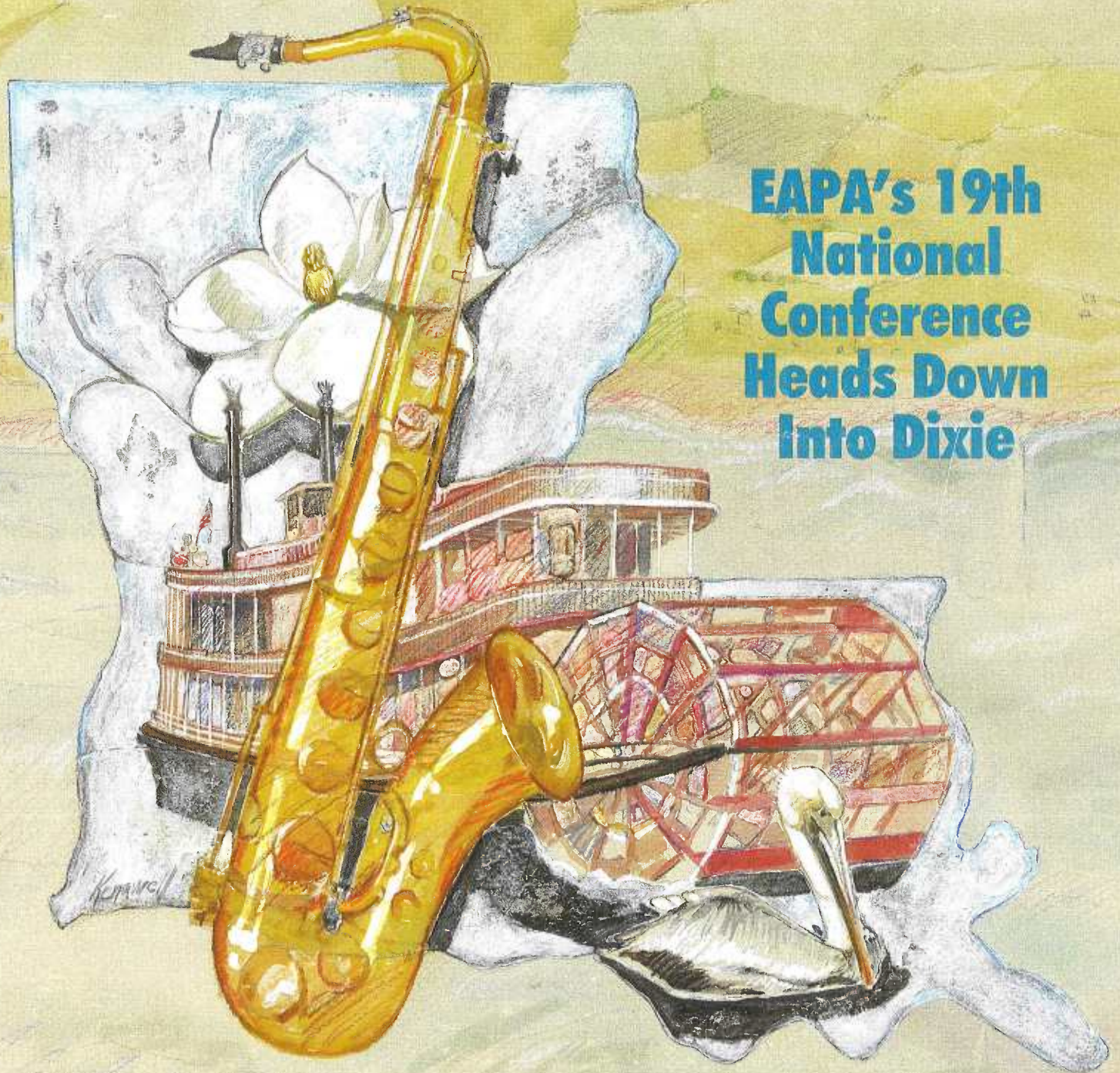

National Conference, which will be held from October 21-24. The Crescent City is renowned as an accommodating host for conventions of all sizes. This year, our conference hall and overnight lodging will be under one roof in The Hyatt Regency New Orleans. EAPA conference planner Judith Evans is cooking up another sensational program which combines cutting-edge education & training with festivities that afford conference-goers some after-hours diversions.

The annual "Call for Papers" is published on pages 14-19. The conference theme will be "Basics to Beyond." A revised format is being used this year. With the exception of the research workshops, tracks will not be used. Instead, free-floating workshops—each assigned a PDH Content Area—are listed. (The workshops will be scheduled concurrently as in prior years.) Other than that, one can expect the same high caliber of workshops as EAPA members have become accustomed to attending. We hope you will review the menu of workshops, identify one or more topics that you feel qualified to speak on, and respond

to our "Call for Papers."

Respondents will be notified in May about whether their submissions

have been accepted, and the advance workshop program will be published in the July issue.

**OUR SECOND THEME** in this issue pertains to Professional Development. EAPA is charting new directions in its work to help the EAP field in its professionalization. Fourteen pages describe the association's activities, provide a historical perspective on curricula development in higher education, and list a catalog of academic institutions with EAP curriculums. Also included are two pages about EAPs which serve faculty and other employees at colleges and universities.
