the university, declared yesterday.

Dr. Stone and Lad F. Grapski, director of the hospital, were the speakers at the annual benefit Autumn Festival of the auxiliary board at the Hotel Emerson. "The First Lady of Mary-

land," Mrs. J. Millard Tawes was the honor guest.

More than 600 women and a few men were in attendance. Mrs. Mervin G. Pierpont, president, presided.

THE MEMBERS of the Auxiliary Board were termed Ambassadors of Good Will, Angels of Mercy and wonderful financiers by Mr. Grapski, who related that the women worked hard to promote the hospital and raise money for it.

Dr. Stone said:

"The Hospital is 132 years old and the Women's Auxiliary Board was organized in 1887. The board has done so much for the hospital in so many ways."

Dr. Donald Kerr, minister of the Roland Park Presbyterian Church, gave the invocation.
