'Health Education'

Emphasis will be placed on education and self-help for the individual during "Health Day," to be sponsored May 9 by the Auxiliary of the University of Maryland Hospital.

The event, to start with registration from 9:15 a.m. to 9:45 a.m., will be held at the medical school teaching facility, 10 South Pine street.

Bruce McFaddon, director of the hospital, will address the group between 9:45 a.m. and 10 a.m. From 10 a.m. to noon, a panel of doctors will discuss many crucial concerns—cancer, heart disease and hypertension and gynecological problems.

Lunch, from noon until 12:40 p.m. will be followed by a seminar on "Illness," i.e. "How do I Live with it?" Areas of discussion here will deal with

mastectomy and ostomy, arthritis, heart disease, skin problems and illness in the family. From 1:35 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. workshops will be held on "Prevention"—vision care, dental health, gastrointestinal and respiratory health. Guest lecturers will be professionals from the University of Maryland medical and dental schools.
