Dr. Maureen Henderson, professor and chairman of the department of preventive medicine at the University of Maryland Medical School, will speak at 10.30 A.M. April 26 to the members of the woman's auxiliary of the University of Maryland Hospital. Dr. Henderson will speak on "preventive medicine and health maintenance" in the hospital board room. The meeting is open to members and interested public.

At present Dr. Henderson is heading broad studies of hypertension and of multiple risk factors in coronary disease.

Doctor to talk on health care
