Subject: Response to Chancellor's "First Approximation
Report"- A Hospital Plan

As far as physical space in the Hospital is concerned, the Auxiliary plans to move into its new Gift Shop soon and intends to remain in business at that location.

The Auxiliary also shares space (a desk, some file cabinets and storage closet) in the Volunteer Service Office.

At this time, plans are underway for the redecoration of the North Hospital Lobby--the cost of the professional plans and furnishings to be paid for by the Auxiliary and the costs of painting, electrical wiring and such physical changes to be born by the Hospital. Plans are also in progress for the redecoration of various waiting rooms (10th floor south rotunda, 3rd floor south room E-519, 5th floor south room for nursing mothers); the costs to be similarly divided.

The Auxiliary has also paid for professional plans for two waiting rooms on the 6th floor south. In addition, the Auxiliary is trying to enhance the existing waiting rooms and areas in the North Hospital by arranging furniture, providing lamps, plants and wall hangings.
