Plans for your group as follows: Charter bus and guide to meet the ladies at the lower parking lot of the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen for a 9:30 a.m. departure on Wednesday, March 26, 1980.

Highlights of the tour will include stops at the handsomely renovated City Hall for a full tour of the civic building, over 100 years old, and yet entirely refurbished on the interior. Then to the Shot Tower for a sight & sound presentation. A drive through the areas of Feels Point, old maritime community and the lovely in-town park, Mt. Vernon Place; also see the new Baltimore Convention Center, the World Trade Center, the Flag House, etc. on the way to the Carroll Mansion, once home of a signer of the Declaration of Independence. Luncheon at Jack's Deli on Corned Beef Row (most informal) and then on to see the \$1 homes of Otterbein and the view from Federal Hill. Tour's final stop will be the new observation section at the World Trade Center, located on the 27th floor. Return to the Cathedral at about 3 p.m.
