National Science Foundation — Higher Education Research and Development Survey

Based on reported Fiscal Year 2016 expenditures of \$393.9 million from all sources, the University of Maryland, Baltimore ranks 38th in higher education R&D expenditures at public institutions and 58th among all public and private institutions. Within the life sciences field, UMB ranks 17th among public institutions and 33rd among all public and private institutions.
