Investigator Resources

- UMB ICTR provides three mechanisms for delivering **FREE** resources and funding for clinical and translational research and to facilitate community-focused research.
 - **ICTR Free Cores of Services** – Applications Accepted 24/7!
 - **ICTR Voucher Program** – Applications Accepted Every 2 Months
 - **ATIP Grant Program** – Applications Accepted Yearly



ICTR Free Cores of Services

- **Biostatistics** – study design, analysis, obtaining data from outside resources, and safety monitoring, reports and publications, etc.
- **Informatics** – help with data capture and reporting with REDCap, Qualtrics, TeleForm, access to and help with clinical data, data use agreement support, quality assurance/control, etc.
- **Community-Engaged Research** – help creating community focus group and interpreting results, recruitment videos, assembling an advisory board, etc.
- **Studios** – “round-table” discussions with multidisciplinary experts to assist researchers with hypothesis generation, study design, implementation, etc.

ICTR Voucher Program

ICTR Vouchers - up to \$5k for unfunded projects and up to \$10k for funded projects
- help defray costs of:

- **Campus services offered on the UMB campus, such as:**

- Structural Biology Facilities
- Clinical Resource Facilities, such as the General Clinical Research Center (GCRC)
- Nucleic Acid & Genomic
- Animal Model Resources
- Imaging Technologies
- Drug Development Resources
- Cytometric & Bioassy
- BIORESO, etc.

- **Community-engaged Research Expenses, such as:**

- Meeting hall fees
- Consultation fees
- Focus group fees

ATIP Grant Program

Accelerated Translational Incubator Pilot (ATIP) Grants

- Provides starter funds for projects specifically focused on innovative, translational research that will contribute to the development of new therapies, devices, or approaches to clinical research.
- Encourages interdisciplinary collaborations across campus
- Awards pilot grants up to \$50,000 to investigators at UMB with some awards earmarked for community-focused research.
