August 31st 1900

I received my pay this morning and hasten to enclose the check for \$100 so that you may get it in good time by the mail that goes off tomorrow. I shall not stop to write much because lunch is waiting. Am still bathing in the sea and having a good time. I handed the hat to Mrs. Stark this morning and she will call and see you soon after you get this letter. You will find her very pleasant and she will be much interested in little Mabel. My monthly bill for board was \$35.20.
