

Dr. Luana Colloca is an associate professor at the University of Maryland School of Nursing and School of Medicine, Baltimore, and faculty member of the UMB Center to Advance Chronic Pain Research.

Dr. Colloca holds an MD, a master degree in Bioethics, and a PhD in Neuroscience.

Luana completed a post-doc training at the Karolinska Institute in Stockholm, Sweden and a senior research fellowship at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, USA.

Dr. Colloca has established herself as an outstanding independent scholar producing critical research on the neurobiological bases of endogenous pain modulatory systems in humans.

She recently received the International Patrick Wall Award.

Dr. Colloca has been awarded a four-year, \$2,132,372, grant from the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research, National Institutes of Health, for a research project on Chronic Orofacial Pain and Endogenous Modulatory Systems.
