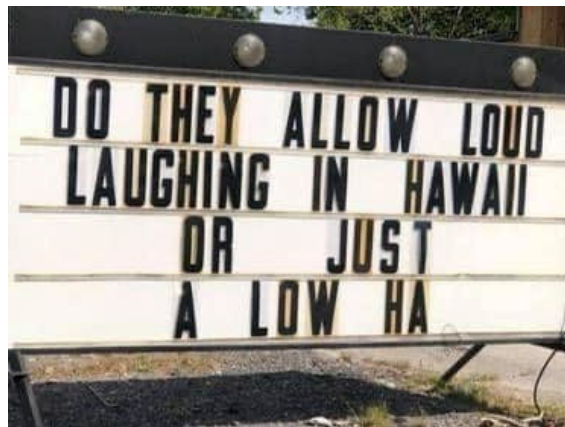
Thanks to those who attended my office hours this week. I had a good time presenting and appreciated the feedback and conversation!
