E. Robert Feroli Jr., PharmD, FASHP

E. Robert Feroli Jr., PharmD, FASHP is the medication safety officer for the Johns Hopkins Hospital and is based in the Department of Pharmacy. He teaches on topics of rational therapeutics and safe medication-use practices, and has faculty appointments at The Johns Hopkins University Schools of Medicine and Nursing, and the University of Maryland Schools of Pharmacy and Nursing. Dr. Feroli received his Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy in 1973, and his Doctor of Pharmacy degree in 1978, both from the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy.

At Hopkins, Dr. Feroli has established a Medication-Use Safety Pharmacy Specialty Residency, which has had two graduates, both of whom are now practicing as medication safety officers. He oversees the monitoring of medication errors and efforts designed to prevent errors before they occur. In this regard, he is Chairman of Hopkin's Medication Error Reduction Implementation Team (MERIT), which is a subcommittee of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee and is charged with overseeing issues involving the safe use of medications.

Prior to his current position, Dr. Feroli had the opportunity to serve in a number of capacities at Johns Hopkins Hospital: as a Drug Information Pharmacist, an Assistant Pharmacy Director of Clinical Services, Director of the Investigational Drug Service, and Interim Pharmacy Department Director. He obtained additional training through programs sponsored by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists: Pharmacy Management Curriculum, which emphasizes clinical leadership, and Competitive Edge, emphasizing clinical and economic outcomes research.

Dr. Feroli has been very active in pharmacy-oriented state societies and governmental agencies. He has served the Maryland Society of Health-System Pharmacists (MSHP) as a member of numerous committees, as secretary, as a member of its Board of Directors, and as president. MSHP named him Hospital Pharmacist of the Year in 1981 and presented him with its highest honor, the W. Arthur Purdum Award, in 2003. In 2005, Dr. Feroli was named a fellow of the American Society of Health-system Pharmacists.
