Ceremonial maces are ornamental staffs made of wood and metal that are carried by an honored designee at graduation or at other significant University events. The mace is a focal point of the beginning and ending processionals. The School of Nursing's mace was presented to the School at Convocation 2014 by Jay A. Perman, MD, president of the University of Maryland, Baltimore, as part of the School's 125th anniversary celebration.

The School of Nursing's mace was crafted by Bruce Jarrell, MD, FACS, chief academic and research officer, senior vice president, and dean of the Graduate School, with the assistance of his daughter, Gwynneth, BSN '06. The walnut staff is topped with a bronze and copper replica of the School of Nursing alumni pin. The design of the steel mace holder is based on elements of the Maryland state flag and was created by Ukrainian blacksmith Anatoily Rudek in collaboration with Dr. Jarrell. The oak and ebony base was crafted by Dr. Jarrell's sister, Bess Naylor, who earned a master's degree from the School of Medicine in 1977. When not in use, the mace is prominently displayed in the School of Nursing lobby.

University of Maryland Medical Center

Lisa Rowen, DNSc, RN, CENP, FAAN, the Chief Nurse Executive for the University of Maryland Medical System, a 12-hospital health system, serves as the System's leader for nursing practice, standards of care, and issues related to and of importance to nurses. She also has served as the Senior Vice President for Patient Care Services and Chief Nursing Officer at the University of Maryland Medical Center (UMMC) since 2007 and oversees 5,000 nurses, advanced practice nurses, and other health professionals. Before

coming to UMMC, Dr. Rowen served as Director of Surgical Nursing at The Johns Hopkins Hospital, where she began her career as a surgical nurse, and Vice President for Patient Care Services at Mercy Medical Center. Dr. Rowen is a Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing. She has served as a journal editor and has published more than 70 articles on patient safety, teamwork and communication, health-related issues, and best practice standards. As the principal investigator for an American Organization of Nurse Executives funded study, Dr. Rowen studies and presents frequently on leadership development and patient outcomes. She is an Associate Professor at the University of Maryland School of Nursing (UMSON) and also holds faculty appointments at the University of Virginia, Johns Hopkins University, and Northeastern University. Dr. Rowen earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in art history and a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing at the University of Delaware, a Master of Science degree at UMSON, and a Doctor of Nursing Science degree at Johns Hopkins University. She was inducted into the University of Delaware Wall of Fame and was selected as the Giving Excellence Meaning winner for "Advancing and Leading the Profession" for the Maryland-DC-Virginia region from Nurse.com. Dr. Rowen was inducted into the Circle of Excellence of Maryland's Top 100 Women, after inclusion on the Maryland's Top 100 Women lists in 2009, 2011, and 2013. UMSON recently selected Dr. Rowen as a recipient of the Visionary Pioneer Award, an award for outstanding alumni who have significantly impacted and contributed to the nursing profession based on entrepreneurship, innovation, and leadership.

The Dean's Medal for Distinguished Service

In 2017, Dean Jane Kirschling established the Dean's Medal for Distinguished Service to recognize those, external to the institution, who have demonstrated "an exceptional commitment to advancing the University of Maryland School of Nursing and its mission."

This year's inaugural recipients of the Dean's Medal are William and Joanne Conway. Bill Conway, the co-chief executive officer and co-founder of the Carlyle Group in Washington, D.C., and his wife, Joanne, decided several years ago that they wanted their philanthropy to help individuals with demonstrated financial need receive the education necessary to obtain jobs. Further reflecting upon the assistance their families had received from compassionate and caring nurses, as well as the tremendous need for additional nurses, the Conways chose to invest in nursing education.

Since 2015, the University of Maryland School of Nursing has received two transformational gifts from the Conways through their Bedford Falls Foundation. These gifts, which total more than \$7 million, have created extraordinary opportunities for individuals with financial need to pursue entry-level or advanced nursing degrees. The first gift has allowed the School to provide full scholarship support to students in the traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program and to registered nurses returning to school to pursue their BSN degrees. The second gift is funding scholarships for students pursuing advanced education through master's and doctoral degrees, as well as through the post-master's Certificate in Teaching in Nursing and Health Professions. Recipients of these scholarships are known as Conway Scholars. The Conways' most recent gift is also assisting in expanding the School's Family Nurse Practitioner specialty to the Universities at Shady Grove, thereby increasing educational opportunities for students throughout Maryland.

Through their vision and generosity, the Conways not only are changing the lives of current and future nursing students, but also are profoundly impacting the patients, families, and communities that these dedicated nurses will serve.

This year's medals have been crafted by hand by Bruce Jarrell, MD, FACS, Chief Academic and Research Officer and Senior Vice President, University of Maryland, Baltimore. Dr. Jarrell, a surgeon by training, is an avid metal artisan who also created the School of Nursing's ceremonial mace.

The DAISY in Training Award

The DAISY in Training Award is supported through the generous gift of Cynthia Sweeney, MSN, BSN '76, RN, CNOR, NEA-BC, Executive Director of the DAISY Foundation. The DAISY (Disease Attacking the Immune System) Foundation was established in 1999 by the family of Patrick Barnes, who died at 33 from complications of Idiopathic Thrombocytopenic Purpura. After his death, his family reflected on the amazing care he—and all the family received from Pat's nurses. As a result of their experience, the Barnes family believes that nurses are unsung heroes of our society, and The DAISY foundation works specifically to say "thank you" to them. The DAISY in Training Award recognizes nursing graduates who provide outstanding compassion and care to patients and their families.

In addition to the award certificate and pin, DAISY in Training Award winners receive the Healer's Touch sculpture. Each piece is hand carved by artists of Zimbabwe's Shona Tribe, which holds its healers in a position of great importance to the community. The DAISY Foundation supports 14 artists carving these sculptures; this is their only work, and with the money the foundation pays, some 500 people in the artists' extended families are supported.
