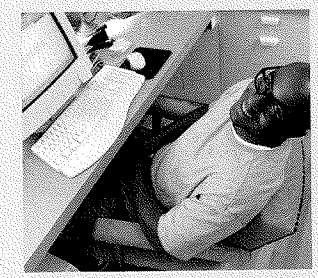
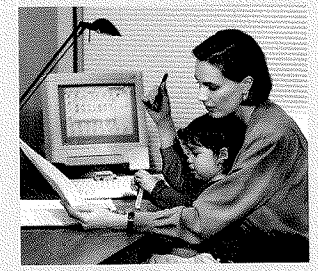

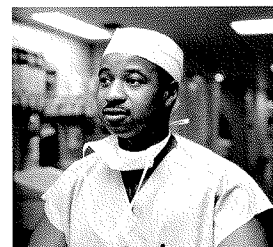

RNTC 323 – Nursing Concepts

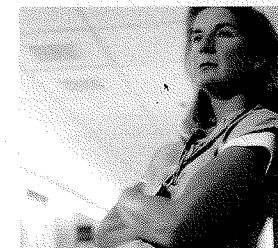


TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

In order to take advantage of the online option, students will need to be equipped with the following:

- Internet access through an Internet Service Provider (ISP) — 56K modem or faster
- UMnet Account – Free to all students of the School
- Minimum of Pentium 200 or Mac OS 7
- Sound card and speakers
- Netscape Communicator or Internet Explorer 5 (preferred)
- Real Player 8 Basic
- Adobe Acrobat Reader
