

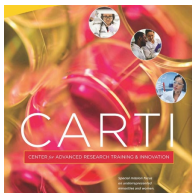

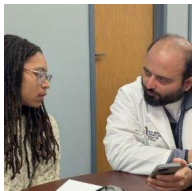


#### **CARTI is Now Accepting Applications for 2025 "Basic Science Research Training Track"**

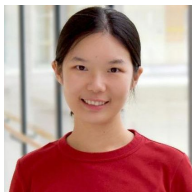
