ANTHONY FAUCI, MD

*Director, National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases

In assessing Anthony Fauci's long and distinguished medical and scientific career, it's difficult to pick just one accomplishment as being the most impactful.

Groundbreaking research that led to the creation of drugs and therapies to fight HIV, the virus that causes AIDS? Development of the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief, a program that has saved over 20 million lives throughout the developing world? Serving as director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) for 38 years? Advising seven U.S. presidents on emerging and infectious diseases such as COVID-19?

Fauci is proud of them all, but perhaps partial to his and his institute's work on the AIDS epidemic.

"Early in my career as a basic scientist, I helped develop effective therapies for a number of formerly fatal inflammatory diseases," said Fauci, who also is the chief medical advisor to President Joe Biden. "In the 1980s, I changed the direction of my research to focus predominantly on HIV. I think that is the most profound of my accomplishments: I started the AIDS program at NIAID, and the institute has played a major role in developing and testing most of the therapies that wound up saving millions of lives."

At NIAID, Fauci oversees an extensive portfolio of basic and applied research to prevent, diagnose, and treat established infectious diseases, respiratory infections, diarrheal diseases, tuberculosis, and malaria as well as emerging diseases such as Ebola,

Zika, and COVID-19.

He has received numerous prestigious awards, including the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the highest honor that can be given to a U.S. civilian, from President George W. Bush in 2008, and the National Medal of Science.

"For decades, Dr. Fauci has advised the country on domestic and global health threats," said UMB President Bruce E. Jarrell, MD, FACS. "He has been at the forefront of the battle against COVID-19, serving as a thoughtful and reasonable voice during this crisis, firmly dedicated to putting science first and saving lives."

Fauci and NIAID have worked closely with the University of Maryland School of Medicine (UMSOM) and its Center for Vaccine Development and Global Health (CVD) during the pandemic, continuing a long and impactful collaboration.

"One of the main components of NIH-funded vaccinology has been the University of Maryland School of Medicine," Fauci said. "The scientists there have been at the core of all vaccine studies for decades and decades, and I appreciate the work they've done with us in the past and in particular on COVID-19."

The feeling is mutual, says the director of CVD.

"Dr. Fauci's leadership during the pandemic has been unparalleled," said Kathleen Neuzil, MD, MPH, FIDSA, the Myron M. Levine, MD, DTPH, Professor of Vaccinology at UMSOM. "He has been steadfast and courageous in advocating for strong science as the foundation for all public health decisions."

Honorary Degree Recipient

CHRISTINE GRADY, PHD, MSN
*Chief, Department of Bioethics
National Institutes of Health Clinical Center*

Nurse-bioethicist Christine Grady has had a front-row seat to the United States' response to COVID-19 for the past two years and hopes the one thing that Americans learn from the pandemic is to care for each other.

Grady, who has served as chief of the Department of Bioethics at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Clinical Center for the past 10 years, has studied ethical implications of the pandemic such as the inequities of treatment, rollout of the vaccines, and effects of the pandemic on nurses.

"There are so many important ethical challenges that emerged during COVID," said Grady, who also is senior investigator at the NIH Clinical Center. "One very large and complex ethical challenge that COVID has shined a light on is inequity — in society and in health care. We must all work to correct inequities."

Grady's work is known internationally, and she has lectured on ethical issues in clinical research and clinical care, HIV disease, and nursing. Her research has focused on the ethics of clinical research, including informed consent, vulnerability, study design, and recruitment as well as ethical issues faced by nurses and other health care providers.

"Being an early nurse-bioethicist has given me the opportunity to synergize what I learned from both nursing and bioethics to deliver high-quality consultation, education, and research and move the field forward," said Grady, whose

husband is Anthony Fauci, MD, director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases. Both will receive honorary degrees during the University of Maryland, Baltimore's (UMB) 2022 commencement.

"I was very surprised and truly honored to be recognized in this way," said Grady, who described herself as "an enthusiastic supporter" of UMB's mission to improve the human condition and serve the public good.

Fauci, the chief medical advisor to President Joe Biden, calls Grady his rock and his anchor.

"She's intellectually brilliant, but she also has incredibly good judgment and has a different personality profile than mine. She's very calm, very reserved, but a very analytical thinker," Fauci said. "And with all the pressure that I'm under, which is considerable, she keeps me well-grounded and focused on what's important. And she helps me to not let things distract me that are ridiculous.

"She's the balance. She's the anchor of reality in my life — not to mention the fact that she's an accomplished person on her own."

Despite her many accomplishments, Grady says she still has at least one goal she wants to achieve.

"I want to find ways to promote moral strength and moral decision-making, and to mitigate moral distress experienced by nurses, health care professionals, and others," she said.

Honorary University Marshal

ANTHONY LEHMAN, MD, MSPH
Professor, Department of Psychiatry
Senior Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs
School of Medicine

Anthony Lehman has worked at the University of Maryland School of Medicine (UMSOM) since 1986. Much of his research is focused on examining the outcomes of people with severe and persistent mental illnesses, in particular assessing quality of life.

He also has studied the impact of substance use disorders among persons with mental illnesses on diagnosis and outcomes, the effectiveness of PACT (Programs of Assertive Community Treatment) for homeless people with severe mental disorders, and the quality of care for people with schizophrenia.

“I am proud of my early community research to develop and apply novel approaches to improving the lives of fellow citizens with serious mental illnesses and addictions,” Lehman said. “My tenure as chair of the Department of Psychiatry offered me a wonderful opportunity to advance our educational, clinical, and research missions in psychiatry and to encourage the careers of many young faculty and trainees.”

Lehman has written more than 150 scientific articles and co-authored the books “Working with Families of the Mentally Ill” and “Double Jeopardy: Chronic Mental Illness and Substance Use Disorders.”

He was the principal investigator for the Schizophrenia Patient Outcomes Research Team, funded by the Agency for Health Care Policy and Research and the National Institute of Mental Health, and the Maryland Employment Demonstration Project for Persons

with Psychiatric Disabilities, funded by the Center for Mental Health Services.

Lehman was director of UMSOM’s Center for Mental Health Services Research from 1986 to 2002, then served as acting chair and chair of the Department of Psychiatry from 1998 to 2014. Before joining UMSOM, he was director of the University of Rochester’s Long-Term Care Program from 1981 to 1986. He earned his bachelor’s degree from St. Lawrence University and his medical degree from the University of Rochester.

His honors include the Senior Award for Research Development in Psychiatric Services Research and the Alexander Gralnick Award for Research in Schizophrenia, both from the American Psychiatric Association; the Distinguished Service Award from the National Alliance for the Mentally Ill; and the Robert Cancro Best Chair Award from the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.

Lehman said he was honored to be part of UMB’s commencement “and excited to again participate in an essential event for the University.”

“It will be wonderful to be with everyone in person again,” he added. “I’m excited to hear Dr. Anthony Fauci’s speech, and I’m honored to be included in an event with such a public health hero.”

Honorary Faculty Marshal

DEBORAH GIOIA, PHD, LCSW-C

Associate Professor

School of Social Work

Deborah Gioia began teaching at the University of Maryland School of Social Work (UMSSW) in 2006. During her tenure, she has taught and mentored social work students in the master's and PhD programs, specializing in teaching qualitative research methods and clinical courses, and twice co-led an international course in India.

In her research pursuits, she has studied the mental health outcomes of veterans returning from the Afghanistan and Iraq wars and assessed Baltimore elementary school teachers involved in a wellness program. Her other research interests include schizophrenia and vocational identity, evidence-based practice adoption by mental health practitioners, adolescence and emerging adulthood, and first-episode psychosis.

Among her accomplishments, she is particularly proud of her work as a GLOBALtime teaching fellow with the UMB Center for Global Engagement, recounting a 2019 trip to Kerala, India.

"The Center for Global Engagement assisted us with a grant to reduce the cost for more than two weeks of travel for students, some of whom who had never been out of the country," she said. "Seeing students flourish on this trip and navigate new spaces with their social work student peers in India was the ultimate gift."

Gioia received her bachelor's degree from Northeastern

University, her Master of Science in Social Work degree from Columbia University, and her PhD from the University of Southern California. She said her dissertation, "Meaning of Work for Young Adults with Schizophrenia: A Mixed-Methods Study," enabled her to develop her own original research agenda.

Before joining UMSSW, she was an assistant professor at the University of Michigan School of Social Work and an adjunct professor at the Johns Hopkins University Bloomberg School of Public Health, the Simmons College School of Social Work, and the UCLA School of Public Policy and Social Research. She has been a licensed certified social worker since 2010 and is a member of the Academy of Certified Social Workers and a Diplomate in Clinical Social Work through the National Association of Social Workers.

Gioia said she was honored to be chosen as an Honorary Faculty Marshal and is excited to hear from keynote speaker Anthony Fauci, MD.

"It stirs a feeling of pride to be part of the UMB family celebrating our graduates," she said. "Dr. Fauci was such a constant presence during the peak COVID period that I began to feel that he was part of my coping mechanisms and support system. I am sure his speech will be inspirational."

Honorary Faculty Marshal

FRANCIS PALUMBO, PHD, JD, MS

*Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Health Services Research
Executive Director, Center on Drugs and Public Policy
School of Pharmacy*

Francis Palumbo has been a valued member of the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy (UMSOP) faculty since 1974 and an adjunct professor at the University of Maryland Francis King Carey School of Law since 1995.

He will soon add the word “retired” to both titles, as he plans to retire June 1, less than two weeks after serving as the University of Maryland, Baltimore’s (UMB) Honorary Faculty Marshal for 2022 commencement.

“Once retired, I will want to stay involved in work to some degree, and I want to be sure that I stay connected to my great colleagues,” Palumbo said. “But I also look forward to spending more time with my wife and family.

“It was an honor to be selected as a marshal,” he added. “It’s also wonderful to know that this will be an in-person event, because I’ve sorely missed the personal interaction with my colleagues and students.”

Palumbo has mentored countless master’s and PhD students at UMSOP and taught pharmacy management, medical care organization, health economics, and pharmacy law. He also co-founded the school’s Pharmaceutical Health Services Research graduate program and the Center on Drugs and Public Policy. At Maryland Carey Law, he teaches a course in food and drug law. Pharmacy and law students appreciate his deep knowledge,

thoughtful feedback on their papers, and willingness to go the extra mile to help them with their research. This was evident in 2019 when he was named UMB Educator of the Year, bolstered by five nominations from former students.

When asked about his most impactful accomplishment, though, he first points to his UMB colleagues.

“I’ve had the honor to work with so many talented faculty at all of the schools,” Palumbo said. “I’m proud of the research I’ve engaged in and the recognition of that work by being invited to join a National Institutes of Health study section.”

Palumbo’s pharmacy law class helps students prepare for the part of the pharmacist licensure exam that tests their knowledge of federal and state law. In addition, he and his colleagues annually hold a two-day law review session for UMSOP graduates, graduates of other schools, and pharmacists from other states pursuing licensure in Maryland.

Palumbo is a licensed pharmacist and a member of the Maryland and District of Columbia bars. He received his bachelor’s degree in pharmacy from the Medical University of South Carolina, his master’s and PhD in health care administration from the University of Mississippi, and his law degree from the University of Baltimore.

Karen Faraone has studied or worked on the University of Maryland, Baltimore (UMB) campus for 50 years. She graduated from the University of Maryland School of Nursing in 1974 with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree and from the University of Maryland School of Dentistry (UMSOD) in 1978 with a Doctor of Dental Surgery degree.

Faraone accepted a position as an instructor of prosthodontics at UMSOD in 1979, then was promoted to assistant professor in 1982 and clinical associate professor in 1989. Since 2012, she has led the school's Office of Student Affairs with myriad responsibilities including managing a five-person staff, advising student organizations, and overseeing events such as the White Coat Ceremony, Evening with the Stars Awards Ceremony, Honors Convocation, Graduation, and more.

"I've had a tremendously rewarding career at the School of Dentistry," Faraone said. "The school's mission encompasses and supports education, research, and community service — and I was given the opportunity to participate in all three.

"As the associate dean for student affairs, I am very proud of the growth that Student Affairs has cultivated, particularly along the lines of community service and leadership opportunities."

Faraone, who also has a master's degree in instructional systems development, says her most rewarding contributions have come

from developing numerous programs and presentations within her prosthodontics specialty and publishing in the areas of blended curriculum and self-assessment.

She was inducted into the International College of Dentists in 2020 in recognition of her excellence in leadership with an emphasis on service and is a member of the Omicron Kappa Upsilon National Honor Society, where she has served as president, president-elect, vice president, and secretary/treasurer. Katherine Fornili has enjoyed a nearly 40-year career in nursing, including the last 17 as an educator at the University of Maryland School of Nursing (UMSON) teaching addictions nursing, core courses in the Doctor of Nursing Practice program, and clinical instruction in community/public health nursing.

Fornili, who is retiring from UMSON in July, co-developed an addictions nursing elective for undergraduates and a 12-credit addictions nursing certificate program for advanced practice nurses. She also provides interprofessional education on addictions for nurses, physicians, social workers, and other health professionals.

“I feel fortunate to have served as a leader in addictions nursing for many years, primarily through my service to the International Nurses Society on Addictions [IntNSA],” Fornili said. “IntNSA members are nurse advocates for the prevention and treatment of addictions globally. We drive policy change, research, and the destigmatization of addictive disorders.”

Fornili co-edited the third edition of “Addictions Nursing: Scope and Standards of Practice,” a joint publication of IntNSA and the American Nurses Association. She also is an associate editor and contributor to IntNSA’s peer-reviewed periodical, the *Journal of Addictions Nursing*, and is the longtime chair of IntNSA’s Policy Committee.

Fornili is particularly proud of her work with underserved populations in Baltimore at the Our Daily Bread Employment

Center. In 2007, she developed a clinical practicum site where she and a UMSON colleague supervise nursing students who deliver health assessments and care coordination at the Christopher Place Employment Academy, a residential job training program for formerly homeless men.

“Not only do we witness a transformation in these men, who become gainfully employed, self-sufficient, and productive members of society, we also witness a tremendous transformation in the nursing students,” Fornili said. “Through service-based learning, we open the eyes of undergraduate nurses to the needs of the poor and underserved and instill in them a passion for reducing health disparities and promoting health equity. Knowing that I have earned the trust of the men of Christopher Place is probably the most fulfilling accomplishment of my 40-year nursing career.”

Fornili also is a fellow of the International Academy of Addictions Nursing and has won numerous honors, including the Outstanding Service Award from UMSON in 2019 and the Education (2016), Community Service/Advocacy (2008), and Outstanding Contributions to Administration/Management in Addictions Nursing awards (2003) from IntNSA.

She received her bachelor’s degree in nursing and Master’s in Public Health from Virginia Commonwealth University and her Doctor of Nursing Practice degree from UMSON.

ACADEMIC DEGREES AND SYMBOLS

THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE

The bachelor's degree is the oldest academic degree used by American institutions of higher learning. The degree was first conferred in America in 1642 on nine young men comprising the first graduating class of Harvard College. The bachelor's degree, or baccalaureate, represents completion of a four-year collegiate course of study.

THE MASTER'S DEGREE

The master's degree is an academic honor conferred upon students who have successfully completed one or two years of work beyond the baccalaureate. A thesis and an oral examination are usually required. The term's present meaning derives from the oldest universities in Europe, when the circle of academic pursuit was limited to seven liberal arts. Those who received public honors upon the completion of their studies and who already had received the degree baccalaureus were called *magistri artium* (masters of the arts).

THE DOCTORAL DEGREE

Doctor is a term meaning teacher, or instructor, and was applied by ancient Romans to those who delivered public lectures on philosophical subjects. From the 12th century, it became a title of honor for people of great learning. It was first made an academic title at the University of Bologna, in Italy, which received from the emperor the right to appoint *doctores legum* (doctors of laws).

There are two types of doctoral degrees: the professional degree and the research degree. The first represents advanced training for the practice of professions such as medicine, pharmacy, law, or nursing. These degrees carry no implication of original research.

The research doctorate represents prolonged advanced study, usually accompanied by a dissertation designed to make a substantial contribution to existing knowledge on the subject. The degree confers upon those who attain it the title Doctor of Philosophy, although the degree no longer is associated with the study of philosophy. It was first awarded in the United States by Yale University in 1861.

ACADEMIC COSTUME

The traditional black caps and gowns worn in the academic procession have been the costume of scholars since medieval times. They probably were adapted from ecclesiastical garb, because many scholars in the Middle Ages were clerics. In 1895, an intercollegiate commission drafted a uniform code

for academic costumes, which the majority of colleges and universities in the United States have adopted.

Each of the three academic degrees has its own distinctive gown and hood. The gown representing the bachelor's degree has a long, pointed sleeve; the master's a narrow sleeve; the doctor's a full, bell-shaped sleeve with three bars of velvet. The opening of this gown is faced with wide velvet bands, which may be black or of a color indicating the wearer's general field of learning.

The most colorful and distinctive part of the academic costume is the hood, which passes around the neck and extends down the back. The color of the velvet edging indicates the wearer's field of learning. The colors of the silk lining exposed in the center of the hood are those of the college or university that conferred the degree.

Each school/program is represented by the following colors: lilac (dental); purple (law); green (medicine); apricot (nursing); olive (pharmacy); dark blue (philosophy); citron (social work); gold (genetic counseling); teal (physical therapy); and salmon pink (public health).

Although the cap, or mortarboard, is uniform in design for all degrees, the tassel may be either black or the color of the field of learning. The tassel of the doctor's cap may be gold.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE AND MACE HOLDER

The University mace was created for UMB's 1971 commencement and has been used at each subsequent commencement ceremony. The mace, which is a traditional symbol of authority, includes the seal of the state of Maryland, wrought in brass, on a walnut staff. The mace holder was created in 2010 by UMB President Bruce E. Jarrell, MD, FACS, an accomplished metalsmith. Bearing various state and University elements, the mace holder was first used at the inauguration of Jarrell's predecessor as UMB president, Jay A. Perman, MD, in November 2010. Jarrell based the mace holder design on the Maryland state flag, which bears the cross bottony and the palisades of the Calvert and Crossland families of the Lords Baltimore.

THE BANNERS

The 12 commencement banners identify the disciplines whose graduates this ceremony honors. Each banner incorporates the University seal, together with colors that echo the graduates' hoods.

UNIVERSITY of MARYLAND, BALTIMORE

Opened in 1807, the University of Maryland, Baltimore (UMB) is Maryland's public health, law, and human services university, dedicated to excellence in education, research, clinical care, and public service.

UMB enrolls more than 7,200 students in six highly ranked professional schools — dentistry, law, medicine, nursing, pharmacy, and social work — and the interdisciplinary Graduate School. The University offers a total of 86 baccalaureate, master's, doctoral, and professional practice degree programs. Every year, UMB confers most of the professional practice doctoral degrees awarded in Maryland.

UMB is a thriving academic health center combining cutting-edge biomedical research and exceptional patient care. UMB was awarded \$682 million in grants and contracts in Fiscal Year 2021. Now combined as one research enterprise, UMB and the University of Maryland, College Park ranked 16th overall and 10th among public institutions in research and development spending in Fiscal Year 2020.

The University of Maryland BioPark, Baltimore's biggest biotechnology cluster, fuels the commercialization of new drugs, treatments, and devices, giving more than 1,000 scientists and entrepreneurs the space to create and collaborate.

The University of Maryland School of Dentistry, the world's first dental college, continues a tradition of leadership established more than 180 years ago. The school originated the Doctor of Dental Surgery degree, which remains a cornerstone program. In addition, the school offers advanced education in general dentistry and six specialties; Maryland's only baccalaureate dental hygiene program; graduate programs in dental biomedical sciences and experimental pathology; and combined master's and PhD programs. Students, faculty, and staff provide care for 19,000 patients annually in clinics across Maryland. An international research hub, the school works independently and with other institutions to advance the body of knowledge in fields relating to oral health.

FRANCIS KING CAREY SCHOOL OF LAW

Among the oldest and most distinguished law schools in the nation, the University of Maryland Francis King Carey School of Law combines an accomplished and active faculty and a diverse and engaged student body with an unmatched commitment to experiential learning. It is home to nationally ranked specialty programs in health, clinical, and environmental law as well as dispute resolution. Its faculty pursue groundbreaking work in a wide range of subject areas, while its legal clinic delivers more than 75,000 hours of free legal services every year to Maryland residents.

GRADUATE SCHOOL

Graduate studies began at the Baltimore campus of the University of Maryland in the early 1900s. Today, the Graduate School, in partnership with UMB's professional schools, offers certificate, Master of Science (MS), and Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degrees in areas that cover health, biomedical, social, and population sciences. All doctoral students are engaged in research with faculty members to address some of society's most pressing issues.

SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

The University of Maryland School of Medicine was chartered in 1807 as the first public medical school in the United States.
