Dear Dr. Flack:

Mrs. Cuyler, Legislative Chairman, Md. Chapter of the American Physiotherapy Association, has forwarded your letter of September 19 to me. Mrs Cuyler has left Maryland for her permanent residence in Florida, and I have taken over her duties as Legislative Chairman.

In accordance with our understanding of your suggestion to her, we have formed a local organization which is to function as the Maryland State Registry of Physical Therapists. This group includes ethical physical therapists in Maryland who are not members of the National organization, as well as the members of the Md. Chap't. of the American Physiotherapy Association. It will function entirely independently of the national group.

We feel that this State organization should be responsible for our efforts in regard to legislation.

Since I am a member of the legislative committee for this Md. State Registry, you may direct any further correspondence in regard to legislation, to me at the address below.

Though there will be no break in the continuity of our work along the lines of legislation, there has necessarily been a delay due to the changes made .

In answer to your letter of September 19, October 3rd would be too soon for us to have our ideas in regard to a law formulated. We would like to bring our tentative suggestions regarding a law to you by the end of next week (week of Oct. 1) and we will appreciate your help and advice. If you wish us to be ready to meet with the Legislative Council on October 17, please let me know so we can arrange for representative people to be present.
