ORGANIZATION OF THE CURRICULUM

The curriculum pattern for the upper division nursing major has been developed and organized into levels and semesters which provide for comparable lengths of time within levels. All courses begin and end within the boundary of each semester.

The curriculum is divided into two levels:

First level (Junior Year) consist of 3 semesters; two 15 week semesters and one 4 week winter session.

Second level (Senior Year) consist of 3 semesters; two 15 week semesters, and one 4 week winter session.
