### Survey of Recent Nursing Alumni Results

The UM Office of Institutional Research and Accountability recently concluded a survey of AY 2010 Nursing BSN and MS-Clinical Nurse Leader recipients. Of the 398 surveys mailed to graduates, a total of 76 responded including 58 BSN alumni and 18 MS-CNL alumni, resulting in an overall response rate of 19%. However, not all respondents answered all questions. The survey consisted of 17 MHEC required questions, as well as additional questions included by the OIRA and School of Nursing.

Each question is provided below with the selected responses and their frequencies (counts).

The culture is to scare the students and weed out the ones that won't pass boards based on individual assessments of professors. The control and power one professor or clinical instructor has to fail a student is unethical.

- I was an online student for BSN and I did find it hard getting the right information regarding our Commencement Ceremony. I did not have a sash. Also I recommend having medallions for students who graduate with honors.
- My rating of the school is only fair as the quality of instructors is inconsistent. I have had a few phenomenal instructors and many average and a couple pathetic examples. Consistent and enforced standards of performance would help.
- Overall I had a wonderful experience at the UMSON. There were two instructors that were not very helpful that made the experience unpleasant. The nursing statistics class and the community nursing - Both Bad experiences.
- Was a second-degree online student (had previous BA, then ADN). Much of the material was repeated from my ADN and I found online education to be tedious with a lot of misinformation, unclear instruction, unresponsive faculty in some classes, and erroneous links.

MS-CNL

- I feel that the education that I received from UMSON was extremely overpriced for the experience. The CNL program was completely disorganized as was the University itself. Faculty treated students with little respect. Very few instructors made a positive impact on me. UMSON seems more concerned with its prestigious reputation than its students.
